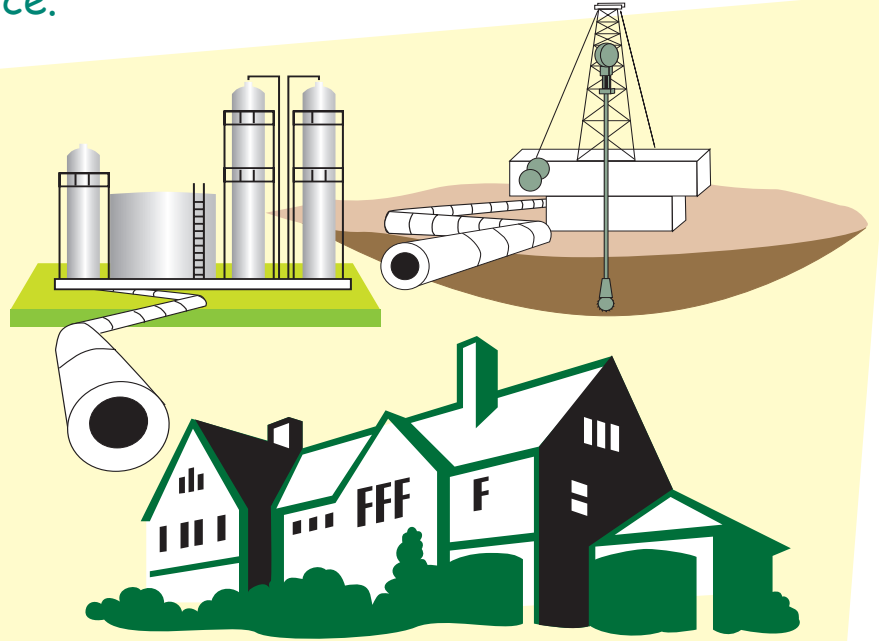


Getting to Know Natural Gas

Gas Facts

- Over one-half of the homes in the U.S. use natural gas as their main heating fuel.
- Natural gas is the cleanest burning fossil fuel.
- Natural gas began with tiny plants and animals that lived more than 200 million years ago—even before dinosaurs roamed the earth!
- When natural gas is burned, it produces mostly carbon dioxide and water vapor. This is what we breathe out when we exhale.

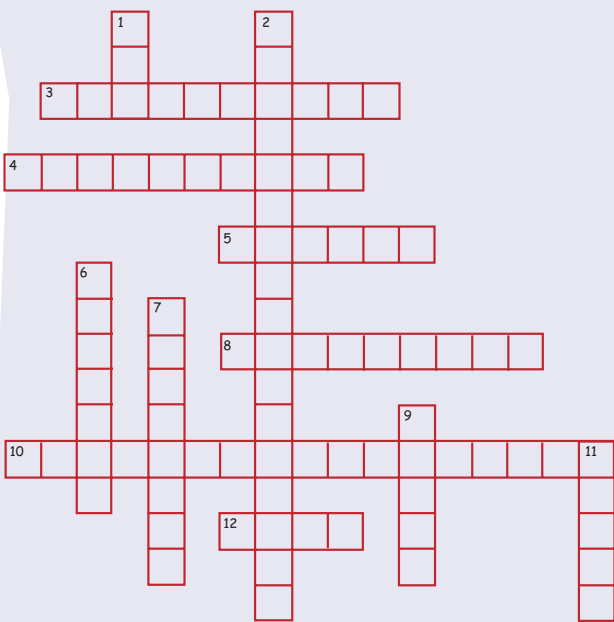
To Your Home

NATURAL GAS is transported directly from the well via underground pipelines to local processing plants then shipped via regional pipelines across the US to be used in homes and businesses.

Natural gas is odorless in the ground. Before it is sent to your house companies add a smelly substance (kind of like "rotten egg") to the gas for safety reasons so that it can be detected in the case of a leak. The natural gas your home uses can fuel your stove, furnaces, water heaters, clothes dryers and other household appliances.

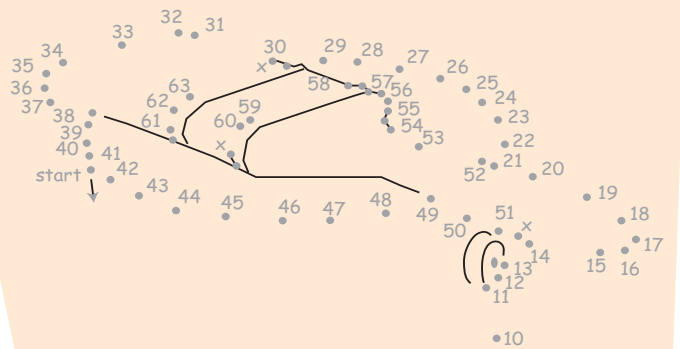
